

GRADUATION SCHOLARSHIP FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Every year, the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) makes funds available from the Federal Foreign Office for scholarships for international students at German universities. The International Office uses these funds to award graduation scholarships, which are intended to enable international students to concentrate on their studies and their forthcoming graduation through financial support. Scholarships of up to 3.000 € each are awarded each semester.

Applications are open to foreign nationals who

- are enrolled at HSD as regular students,
- are in the process of completing their studies (BA / MA within one year)
- are staying in Germany during this phase and
- are in need financially.

Application Documents

- application form
- curriculum vitae
- letter of motivation
- evidence of social / social / intercultural commitment (if applicable)
- current overview of grades with indication of the average grade
- copy of the application for the thesis (if applicable)
- reference letter by a university teacher (see template), to be sent directly to the International Office
- copy of the passport (only the page with the personal data)
- statements of account for the last three months

Selection Process

A commission of the Department of Student and International Affairs makes the selection. There is no legal entitlement to funding.

Application Deadline

15 January for the summer semester / 15 July for the winter semester
