Mobile camera system:

The mobile camera system transmits high-resolution images in real time from various distances to laptops or other display devices. It can be individually adjusted to meet the user's needs, for example in terms of colour settings, image size and contrast. It enables students with visual impairments to follow visual presentations even from a greater distance.

Features: high-resolution Full HD camera (1980 × 1080), suitable for all monitors (HDMI), 1.1–75x magnification, various colour settings, adjustable vertical and horizontal guide lines, adjustable camera head, compatible with Apple Mac and Microsoft Windows.

FM system:

The system consists of a microphone with a transmitter for the speaker and a receiver for the listener. It enables students with hearing impairments to follow seminars at a consistent volume level without disruptive background noise.

Standing desk:

Certain health conditions or impairments make participation in seminars while seated particularly difficult for some students. Our standing desk can help in such cases.

Computer workstation for students who are blind or visually impaired:

There are two workstations for students who are blind or visually impaired, one in the library and one in building 3. These workstations are equipped with a braille display. The computers have the necessary software installed, including a screen reader and text-to-speech programme.

Canteen tray trolley for wheelchair users:

For people with mobility impairments who use a wheelchair, a tray trolley is available in our canteen. It can be easily attached to the front frame of the wheelchair. The trolley has raised edges to prevent the tray from slipping off. It also includes two cup holders.
